



## **AAUW of Oregon Breaking Barriers Achievement Award**

This annual award is given to an Oregon woman currently **NOT** an AAUW member **OR** an Oregon group, organization and/or institution who, within the past five years, has exemplified AAUW's mission in a manner that has had a demonstrative impact on our state's women and girls in the areas of equity and/or education.

### **Criteria**

Each branch, or collaborating group of branches may nominate one candidate through a written (mailed or online via WORD or PDF) application. A committee composed of AAUW members will select the recipient based upon the following criteria:

- ❖ Exemplification of AAUW's mission and goals
- ❖ Demonstrated impact on women and/or girls
- ❖ Demonstrated need in the community for candidate's initiatives
- ❖ Developed collaborations and other outreach
- ❖ Efforts to assure high visibility
- ❖ Applicability of initiatives to a broader audience
- ❖ Planning for ongoing initiatives
- ❖ Recommendation from a collaborating organization
